



## House Rules

1. Guests are permitted to enter public rooms and booked sleeping room only. Illegal actions in the hostel are strictly prohibited.
2. Public rooms located in the hostel: the kitchens on 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floor, reception area and common area on the second floor in room 209.
3. Any illegal activity involving drugs are strictly prohibited on the premise of the hostel.
4. **With the signing of the registration form, the guest agrees to the hostel rules, keeps the rules which are put in rooms at the reception.**
5. **Smoking is strictly prohibited throughout the entire building.** Smoking is only allowed outside of the hostel's area.  
If smoking in prohibited area triggers the smoke/fire alarm thus initiating the automatic extinguishing system and/or firefighters are automatically called to the premise, related costs will be charged on the delinquent.
6. Please turn off all electric devices (including the air conditioning device) and close all windows before leaving the hostel.
7. The hostel staff (receptionist, housekeeping and director) is permitted to enter the guest's room for the purpose of safety, cleaning, maintenance or for the facilitation of any activity involved in the management of the facility
8. Guests can access the hostel's free Wi-Fi, however, downloading and consumption of illegal content via the hostels Wi-Fi is strictly prohibited!
9. If there are any problems, please contact the hostel staff immediately. In case of urgent emergency, call the general emergency line at 112.
10. False alarm of the above general emergency line entails criminal offense proceedings.
11. Upon fire alarm, please follow the green „Exit” signs on the corridor and/or follow the route as highlighted on the evacuation plan.
12. Guests are free to use all items and utensils located in the public rooms and kitchens. We would very much appreciate if you could clean them after yourselves, as you expect it from others.
13. Guests are expected to use toilets and bathrooms in a civilised manner, not throwing papers and towels causing floods.
14. Guests must not disturb other hostel guests and residents of the building after 11 pm, the staff of the hostel is permitted to manage any inconvenience resulting in the disturbance
15. **2B Hostel is not responsible for guests' valuables** placed in the lockers in rooms. Smaller valuables (watch, piece of jewellery) can be placed in the staff's safe for which we take responsibility. Further, paid lockers are available at the reception floor.
16. A deposit of 10 EUR/person must be paid on arrival per guest. The full deposit will be returned at time of departure on condition that the guest has not caused any damage to the hostel.
17. If the damage amount is greater than the deposit paid, then the guest must pay the difference within 3 days.
18. Public areas are under surveillance. For further information, please refer to our Privacy Policy.
19. Only paying guests are permitted in the hostel. If the cameras in the public rooms record the arrival of visitor(s) entering the hostel, we have the right to ask them to leave. In case of resistance from

unauthorised entrants, we reserve the right to hold the acquainted guest accountable, and charge them for 5.000 Ft.- (or equivalent worth of Euro)<sup>1</sup>

20. Guests are fully responsible for all accidents which happen in the hostel or on the hostel's premises. Guest can use the kitchen, the rooms, the bathroom only for their own responsibility.

**21. Check out time from the hostel is 10:00 AM, latest.**

22. For every started hour after the checkout we charge 10 EUR/hour, due to the fact that we must start preparing the rooms for newly arriving guests.

23. The guests agree that Hungarian law (Hungarian Civil Code) is the applicable governing law to resolve all legal disputes, regardless of country of citizenship or origin.
